  - *It was politically divided in the early 1800s.*
  - *economic isolation*
  - *scattered resources also a problem*
  - *Started to use Britain as a model, imported British engineers and equipment; built railroads*
  - *By late 1800s, Germany was unified and had become an industrial and military giant*
5. How did industrialization shift the world balance of power and lead to the rise of global inequality?
  - Increased competition between industrialized nations and poverty in less-developed nations*
    - *Industrialization widened the wealth gap between industrialized and nonindustrialized countries, but also strengthened their economic ties:*
      - *industrialized countries needed a steady supply of raw materials from less-developed lands*
      - *viewed the poor countries as markets for their manufactured goods.*
      - *exploited overseas colonies for resources and markets and started seizing more colonies*
6. What is imperialism and how did industrialization lead to it?
  - The policy of extending one country's rule over many other lands;*
  - Imperialism came from:*
    - *the need for resources to feed the factories of Europe*
    - *the need to develop new markets around the world for the manufactured goods of the factories*
7. Despite the hardships of early workers suffered, how did industrialization benefit society?
  - *Gave Europe tremendous economic power, while Asia and Africa still based on agriculture and small workshops*
  - *Revolutionized all aspects of society from daily life to life expectancy*
